Sr. Senator Mark Kelly

Senator Mark Kelly is a retired U.S. Navy combat pilot, engineer, and NASA astronaut. He lives in Tucson with his wife, former Congresswoman Gabby Giffords. He took office in December 2020 after Arizonans elected him to fill out the remainder of the late Senator John McCain’s term. In 2022, Arizonans elected him to a full six-year term in the Senate. Senator Kelly is the son of two police officers. He attended public schools from elementary school through the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy and U.S. Naval Postgraduate School. As a naval aviator he made two deployments on the aircraft carrier the U.S.S. Midway and flew 39 combat missions in Operation Desert Storm. Senator Kelly was selected as an astronaut in 1996 in the same class as his twin brother, Scott, and has spent more than 50 days in space.

Senator Kelly serves on five Senate committees. These include: The Committee on Armed Services; The Committee on Environment & Public Works; The Special Committee on Aging; The Joint Economic Committee; The Select Committee on Intelligence.
