Congresswoman Adelita Grijalva

Congressional District 7

Adelita Grijalva was elected to the U.S. House of Representatives on September 23, 2025. She was sworn in on November 12 after a seven week delay, the longest in congressional history.

Daughter of former U.S. Representative Raúl Grijalva, she graduated Pueblo High School and the University of Arizona with a Bachelor of Arts degree in political science in 1995. She previously served as a member of the Pima County Board of Supervisors for District 5 from 2021 to 2025 and on the Tucson Unified School District Governing Board from 2002 to 2022. She also served as director of the non-profit juvenile diversion program for Pima County Teen Court for 25 years.

Congresswoman Grijalva won her election by a 2-1 margin. She is the first Latina to represent Arizona in Congress.
